# REGULATIONS 2013 CLACKAMAS COUNTY CHARITABLE GIVING GOLF TOURNAMENT

OLCC does not allow you to bring your own alcoholic beverages to the course property. Alcoholic beverages can be purchased from the clubhouse and refreshment carts.

### FORMAT:

The tournament format consists of an 18 hole, 4-player team scramble beginning at 8 AM. (registration begins at 7:00 AM and carts will depart to tees at 7:55 AM) On every hole, each team member will hit a tee shot. The team then selects one of the tee shots from which to play. All team members then hit their second shots from that location. This procedure is followed until the ball is holed or a team reaches a bogey. One over par is the maximum score allowed on any hole in this tournament.

#### RULES:

TEES

USGA Rules of Golf apply except for local rules of play and those regarding the scramble format including:

1. Each player must contribute at least **two** tee shots during the round.

Women - Forward tees (gold)

- 2. From tee to green each player may place their ball within one club-length of the selected shot, no nearer the hole.
- 3. On the green each player may place their ball within six inches of the selected ball, no nearer the hole.
- 4. If a team has only three players, one person on the team is eligible to hit 2 shots. Prior to beginning play, the team will decide on a rotation and select players #1, #2 and #3. On the team's first hole, player #1 will take 2 shots at each location to the hole. On the second hold, player #2 takes 2 shots, and on the third hole player #3 takes 2 shots. This pattern is then repeated through 18 holes.

## REGULATIONS

All teams must have at least one female/male on the team.

To earn extra money for Backpack Buddies (providing a meal over the weekend for low income lunch recipients we are selling Mulligans and String to improve on your already excellent golf scores.

**Mulligan**: A mulligan, most simply put, is a "do-over." Hit a bad shot? Take a mulligan and replay that stroke. So as you've probably guessed, a mulligan is never "legal" under the <u>Rules of Golf</u>. Mulligans are most often employed during friendly rounds by golf buddies; or during charity or playday tournaments where mulligans are sometimes sold. If mulligans are for sale, that means the golfer can buy, say, three mulligans for a set price each.

- 1. Mulligans are available for \$3/each with a limit of 6 per team for \$15.
- 2. Maximum of 3 mulligans per 9 holes.

### **String Sales:**

- 1. There will be 10-foot lengths of kite string available for \$10 each with a limit of two per team.
- 2. Ten feet can be used on each nine holes.
- 3. The string is used to improve where your ball lies or can be used to make a short putt which is close to the hole.
- 4. As you use the string you cut or mark the string with the length you use and when it is used it is done. No more we trust you to be honest here.

### **Backpack Buddies Tee Facts**

At some of the tee boxes there will be information regarding Backpack Buddies program (as well as a barrel at the luncheon to collect food for the program) and what the charity provides to the community. Make notes on the facts offered because we will be quizzing you on your information gathering skills at the dinner. Prizes will be awarded to those who answer the questions correctly.
