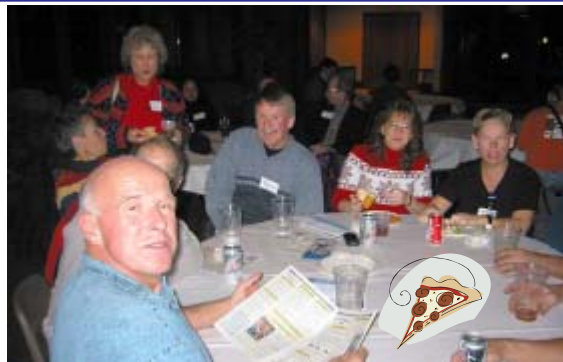

May 27-28: Weekend for staff from 1986 thru 2005.

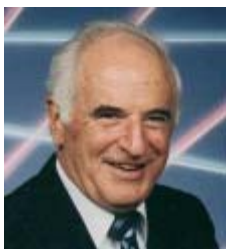

Timberline's "Sky Lift" on the Magic Mile. Capacity: 300 skiers per hour.

This was the second lift built in the world---by Triplett, (if memory serves me right.) The first was built and designed by engineer Jimmy Collins of the Union Pacific RR, being converted from a banana conveyer. Jimmy replaced the original banana hooks with chairs (good move!) and the lift was installed on Dollar Mountain in Sun Valley.

Would you believe **Henry Bendinelli** worked as a loader on this lift? About 1940. Then he graduated upwards to selling tickets, at 35 CENTS per ride. Moreover, he balanced to the penny every day! Whee!

Many years ago, **Hjalmar** informed me "Skiers live a lo-o-o-ng time" and he was so right. Hjalmar skied until age 93.

Every day you ski adds a day onto your lifetime, so go ahead and buy that season pass. You'll be jumping on and off chairlifts, having a BLAST in our gloriuos sport of skiing, while those Couch-Potato acquaintences are pushing wheelchairs around, ---or underneath pushing-up the daisies.

Passports will soon be needed to cross any borders. Here's the timetable:

By Dec. 31, 2005, passports needed for travel to Caribbean and Bermuda.

By Dec. 31, 2006, passports required for all **air** and **sea** travel to or from Mexico and Canada.

By Dec. 31, 2007, passports required for **driving** into Mexico and Canada.

So, get your passport now. You'll need it for our trip to the Alps this coming winter!
