## Canadian Ski Safari 2009/2010 - A Taste of British Columbia

**Minimum: 5 days, Maximum: 9-DAYS**

**Dec. 6 - 10 or 13 or April 6 - 11 or 14**

This is a totally informal road trip. We can carpool, or drive up on our own and meet up there. It's more fun and safer to drive together, as a caravan, but feel free to do it either way. No deposits or reservations are needed. But we'll provide you with directions, phone numbers, etc. Let's just get on the road and experience the adventure!

Ever since November 2003, we have been doing the same 5-day trip, visiting 4 Canadian ski areas (Sun Peaks, Silver Star, Big White and Apex), to take advantage of the Warren Miller free vouchers. In the last 2 or 3 years, we've expanded that by also going a bit further east, if you can spare a few more days.

We can all ski together for the first 4 days, skiing **Big White, Silver Star and Sun Peaks**, and perhaps **Mission Ridge** (on the way to Canada). The average distance between any 2 resorts is only about 2 hours. After skiing at Sun Peaks, we can split up into two groups. Those who can't take more than 4 or 5 days off can head straight home, and maybe stop at **Mt. Baker** or **Grouse Mt.** for one more day of skiing.

Meanwhile, those who can spare a few more days can proceed to **Revelstoke, Kicking Horse, Panorama**, etc. When our muscles can't take it any more, we'll head home!

Start the trip on the afternoon of "Day 0". People can leave after work, and we don't do any skiing on that day. That day, we would travel just about 4 - 5 hours north of Portland, to **Mission Ridge** (near Wenatchee, WA). Ski there on "Day 1". At the end of that day, we'll drive the remaining 5 hours to Big White.

### ITINERARY

Day 0: Start the trip in the afternoon, after work, and drive just 4.5 hours to Wenatchee, WA.

Day 1: Ski **Mission Ridge** (Hwy 97), or **Loup Loup**, or **Apex**.

Day 2: Ski **Big White**

Day 3: Ski **Silver Star**

Day 4: Ski **Revelstoke Mt. Resort** (the newest resort in North America, and the largest vertical, 6000')

Day 5: Ski **Sun Peaks**

Day 6: Ski **Mt. Baker**. Then drive home. Arrive home that same evening.

OR, the LONGER ROUTE:

Day 6: Ski **Kicking Horse** (4,000 vertical feet in a single 10-minute gondola ride)

Day 7: Ski **Panorama** (big vertical)

Day 8: Ski **Kimberley** (great tree skiing). Kimberley is a Bavarian-style town, like Leavenworth, WA.

Day 9: Ski **Silver Mountain** (ID) or **Mt. Spokane** (WA). Then drive home.

It takes abt. 6 hours of driving from Spokane to Portland. Add 1 more hour from Silver Mt., for a total of 7 hours. Even if we ski till they close at 4 pm, we can still be in Portland before midnight. But, we can leave earlier.
