## Mystery trip

### A Mountain High bus trip

**January 15-18, 2010.**

3 days/ 3 nights. The bus trips are usually our club's best and most fun events. The best way to get to know other club members. You don't have to miss any work days, as this is just a weekend (MLK weekend).

We will leave Friday around 5 pm, and return Monday night, by about 8 pm. The bus ride itself will be fun. We'll share some food, play some games, tell some jokes, maybe watch a video,... etc.

We'll visit: ... Oh, wait, we can't tell you. That's part of the mystery! But we can tell you this:

**Skiing:** Lots of variety. Something for everyone. Some great views. Lots of easy and intermediate terrain, but also some hair-raising steeps with moguls! Tree skiing too!

**Lodging:** We'll stay one night at a nice motel, and 2 nights at an even nicer place. Both have a hot tub.

A very basic continental breakfast is included at one motel, and 2 deluxe breakfasts at the other place - with fresh Belgian waffles, Jimmy Dean breakfast sandwiches (bacon, egg, cheese), biscuits and gravy, hard boiled eggs, oatmeal, string cheese and a variety of cereals, breads, pastries, yogurts, fresh fruit, fruit juice, milk, coffee and tea.

Bring some "mystery" food to share on the bus on Friday evening.

**Price:** Approximately **\$326** including bus transportation, 3 lift tickets. 3 nights' lodging. 3 breakfasts and 1 pizza diner.

The trip price is based on 40 people. For each 2 people that sign up over that number, the price for everyone will go down by \$3 - \$4 . (If we fill up the bus with 50 people, the price will go down to \$309 per person. So, let's make sure everyone goes on this trip!

If anyone wants to skip a day of skiing, the middle of the 3 days might be ideal for that. If you want this option, please let us know ahead of time.
